

# The Nu-Phalt Case Study

## Scottish Sealife Sanctuary



The Scottish Sealife Sanctuary is a popular Argyll tourist attraction and home to the SOS Seal Rescue Facility. The Sanctuary relies on tourist revenue to

fund the rescue, rehabilitation and release of injured and abandoned seal pups.



Sealife Sanctuary Attractions Officer Alex Blackman needed a fast solution for repairs needed to their 200-metre approach road. He said "it was getting

to the stage where visitors' cars were risking damage – and something obviously had to be done"

Following successful trials with the Argyll & Bute Council, Nu-Phalt was keen to assist with this project, which also involved creating a parallel cycle track that would form part of a major West Highland circuit planned by cycle route action group Sustrans.



Sustrans Senior Engineer Rowena Colpitts said: "Road repairs carried out by the usual 'heavy construction' methods are generally greedy

in the use of materials and energy, and anything which can repair potholes in a more economic and efficient way



– particularly if the results are long-lasting – has to be very welcome."

The main objectives were to carry out good quality, cost effective repairs whilst minimising disruption. The Nu-phalt asphalt recycling system creates less than a seventh of the carbon emissions associated with old-style repairs, and uses an infra-red burner instead of heavy drilling equipment for a superior, seamless, longer-lasting repair.

The Scottish Sealife Sanctuary's repairs were completed to their satisfaction, and the road was operational again immediately.

Nu-Phalt's Business Development Manager Iain Gardner said

“ We were delighted to be able to meet the needs of The Scottish Sealife Sanctuary for this project; using the Nu-Phalt system, our two man team were able to complete the repairs much more quickly than other traditional systems.
