Safety first with GASTEC and BBA accreditations

In conjunction with GASTEC's seal of approval we look forward to receiving a 'Certificate of No Objection' from the Health & Safety Executive.



We have also successfully completed the initial assessment specification and approval procedure for BBA British Board of Agrément HAPAS accreditation, the UK's major approval body for new construction products and installers. This has involved exhaustive inspections and laboratory testing of our completed repairs to industry best practice for two applications, HRA and Surface dressing.

Nu-Phalt's Health and Safety Manager Richard Wakeman said, "We're delighted to have an official stamp of approval for a system we developed with safety in mind. This is a major year for Nu-Phalt, and further evidence of the Infrared Road Repair System's superior safety performance."
